

First City Dance Studio Protection Plan:

To limit contact the **lobby, changing rooms and team room will be closed.**

- Dancers are asked to escort themselves into the building if old enough.
- If dancer needs parents' assistances, we ask they escort their dancer to the studio then exit the building.
- If your dancers required you to stay in the building, we ask that you wear a face mask as you sit in the lobby.

Dancers are asked to come dressed and ready for class. Dancers will be allowed to bring belongings into the dance room. Dancer will remain in the dance room for the duration of their class.

I will have a receptionist to take monthly tuition, we ask that you send in your monthly tuition with your dancer via Cash/Check. You may enter the studio for all CC transactions. We ask that all communications be done via phone or email.

Other precautions we have (*changed*) taken for the safety of our staff and dancers:

Staff

1. Meet with staff regarding procedures and safety protocols and practices.
2. Self-Temperature taking before class.
3. *Use of protective face masks.*
4. Prohibit on-site food preparation and sharing.
5. No use of office/staff room and equipment such as printers and phones.

Studio

1. Staggered class times.
2. Limit 6 dancers per dance room.
3. *Encourage use of protective face masks for all dancers and parents/guardians.*
4. Use of placement markers to ensure physical distancing in studio.
5. Classes taught outside; weather permitted.
6. Provide hand sanitizer at the entrance of class.

Hygiene/Cleanliness

1. Staff regularly wash their hands.
2. Provide hand-sanitizer and wipes in studio.
3. Encourage use of face masks.
4. Routinely clean and disinfect of all frequently touched items in studio such as props, ballet bars, stereo equipment, door handles and light switches after every use.

We hope these precautions we have (*changed*)taken will bring you comfort in your decision to dance with us.
